November 14, 1975 - May 7, 2020

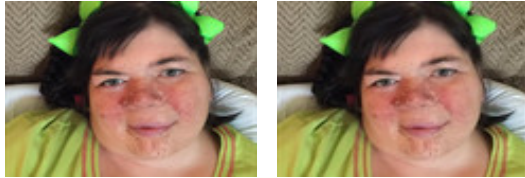
