August 22, 1983 - January 12, 2023

Andrew "Andy" Steven Pratt, 39, of Chesapeake, Ohio, died suddenly on Thursday, January 12, 2023, as a result of a pulmonary embolism. He was born August 22, 1983 in Huntington, West Virginia. Andy was preceded in death by two brothers, Eric and Erin Pratt and maternal grandfather, Papaw Jerry McIntyre, who he referred to as his "best buddy." 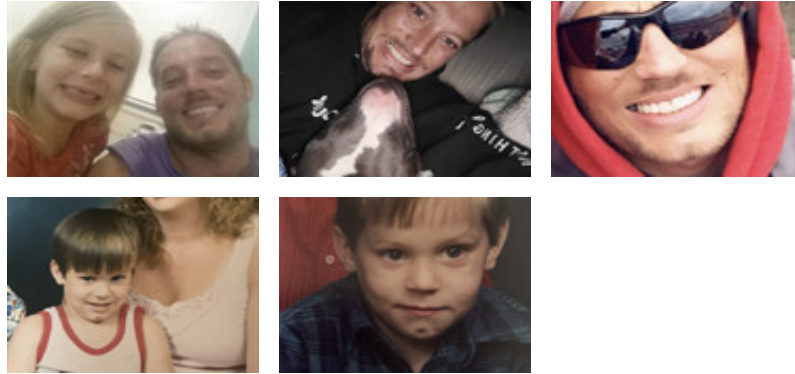
