September 20, 1926 - January 14, 2013

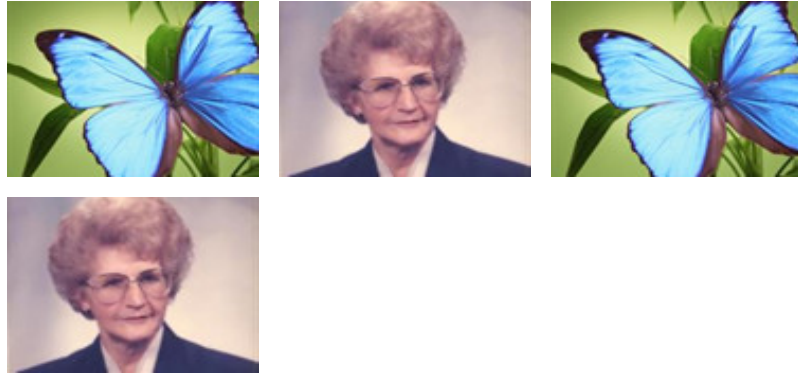
