



Bobby Rogers

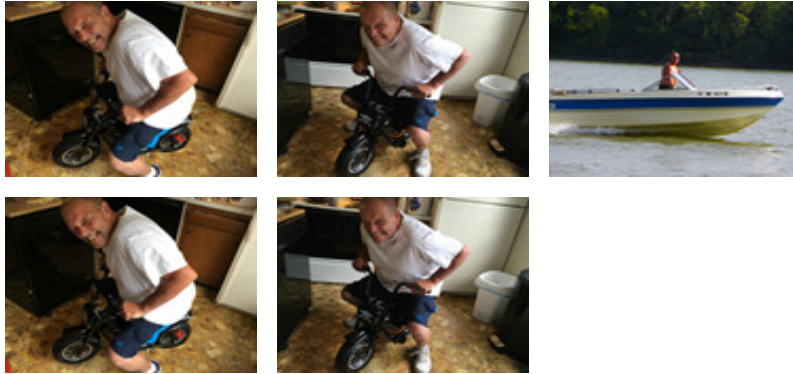
June 18, 1958 - October 9, 2022
