December 29, 1926 - December 22, 2013

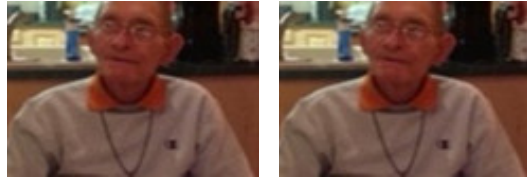
CARL BIBLE HARMON, 86, of Barboursville, WV, passed away Sunday, December 22, 2013, in Cabell Huntington Hospital surrounded by his family and friends. There will be a private family burial in the Prater Family Cemetery.
