February 6, 1922 - May 12, 2017

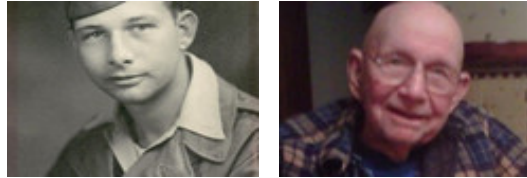
Clayton Walter Wilson, 95, of Ashland, KY (formerly of South Point, OH) passed away on Friday May 12, 2017 at Woodland Oaks in Ashland, KY. He was preceded in death by his parents Glenn B. and Mona Blake Wilson; his wife, V. Catherine Beckett Wilson; three sisters, Lucille Johnson, Carrie Russell and Mary Mooney; two brothers, Glenn B.
