CURTIS R. MILLER, 81, of Chesapeake, OH, went home to be with the Lord, Wednesday, April 2, 2014, in Emogene Dolin Jones Hospice House of Huntington. 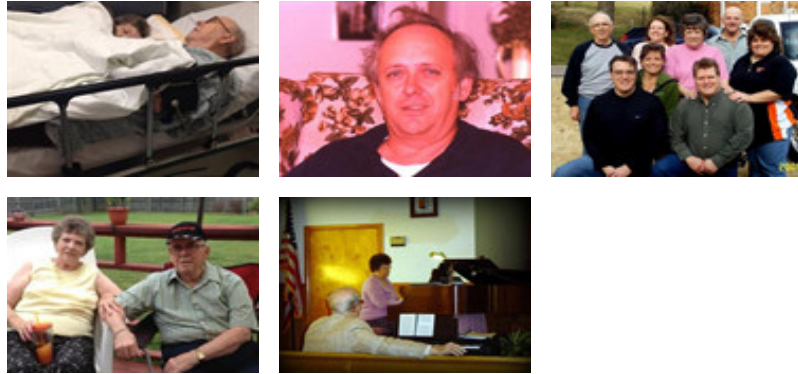
