June 5, 1934 - September 2, 2020

Eva Kathleen Cotton Hughes, 86, went home to be with her Lord on September 2, 2020. She attended Burlington Wesleyan Independent Church (BWIC) and was secretary of the Second Presbyterian Church in Huntington, Wv for eighteen years. She was very active in the BWIC and was the choir director for many years. Eva was born on June 5, 1934 in Huntington, Wv where she lived until she joined the Women's Army Corps in 1956. She met her husband while serving with the US Foreign Service in Beirut, Lebanon and they were married in Cairo, Egypt in 1964 where her husband had been transferred with AMOCO UAR Oil Company. She was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxillary Post 1064 since 1984. She was the daughter of Ellie Lovie Chapman Cotton and William Luther Cotton of Huntington, Wv. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Harry Edward Hughes Jr.; five brothers, William Oliver, James Albert, Harry Thomas, Clifford Ellis and Bobby Ray; one half sister, Carolyn Clay; one step sister, Rhonda Fennell Howard of South Point, OH; one step brother, Kenneth Fennell of Findley, OH and two very special childhood friends who passed at a very young age, Beau Chein (14 yrs old) and Penne Lynn (17 yrs old).
