



Harold Edward Boley

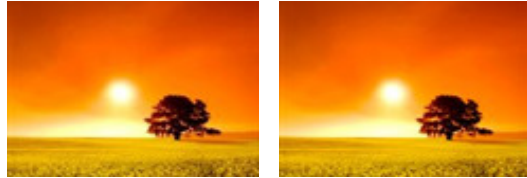
May 21, 1916 - September 28, 2013
