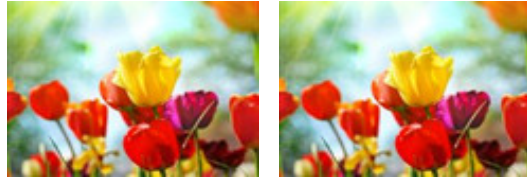
January 12, 1923 - December 5, 2012
