June 3, 1956 - March 8, 2020

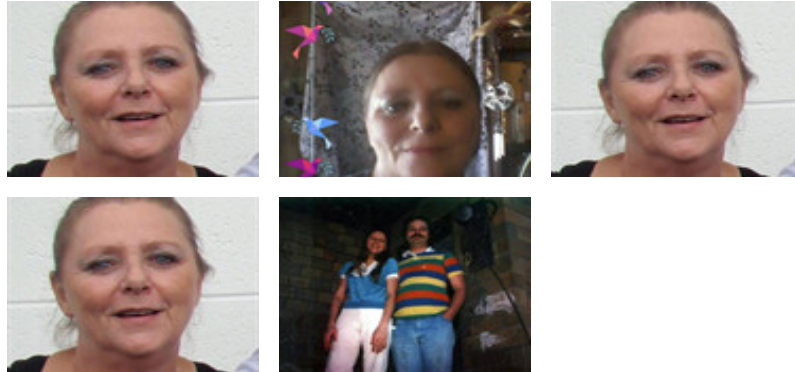
