

Juanita "Rosie" Wilson Mays

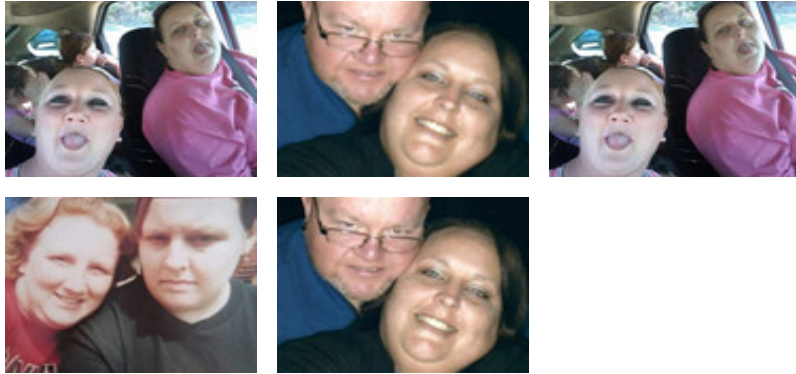
