



## Mary Mildred Bowman

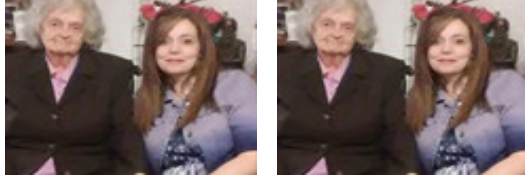
November 8, 1930 - April 24, 2020
