January 27, 1951 - March 29, 2019

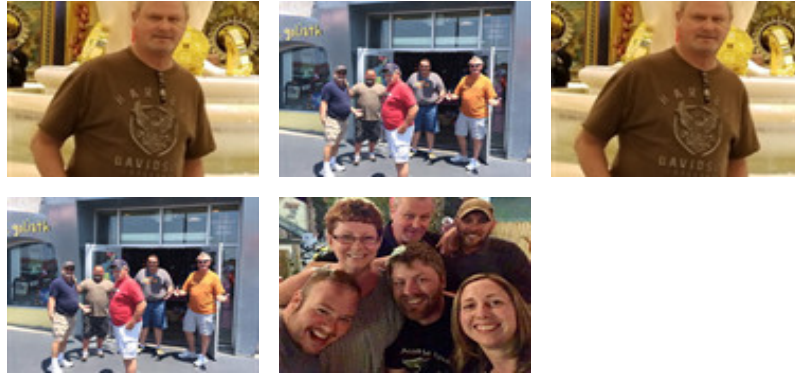
