



## Quincy Jones Milem, Jr.

May 25, 1947 - April 30, 2022

Quincy J Milem, Jr. of South Point, Ohio, passed away Saturday, April 30, 2022 in the care of the Emogene Dolin Jones Hospice House, Huntington, WV.

Quincy proudly served his country in the US Navy, and after 26 years, retired as a SeaBee. He began his career with the Lawrence County Sheriff's Office on September 17, 1984, and retired on December 11, 2008. Quincy was a member of the South Point Chapter of the Grand Lodge of F.&A.M. of Ohio, and the El Hasa Shriners.

Quincy is survived by the love of his life, Deborah Burns Barnett, whom he married on June 16, 1995. Quincy was born the only child of Quincy J. Milem and Ellen Ramey Milem, (both deceased), but he considered his best friend, Tommy Kearns, to be his brother.

Quincy was the father of Brian D. Milem and Kevin M. Milem of South Point, and was a dad to Ricky L. (Gina) Barnett. He was also a grandfather to Jacob, Hunter, and Jenna Gooderham.

Quincy is survived by his aunt, Jo Ramey Hensley and his brother and sisters-in-law, Lucille Burns Johnston, Mary Burns, Richard Burns, Teresa Burns, Delores and Roger Simmons, Danny and Pat Burns, and Rebecca and Jeff Cox.
