January 20, 1949 - September 25, 2022

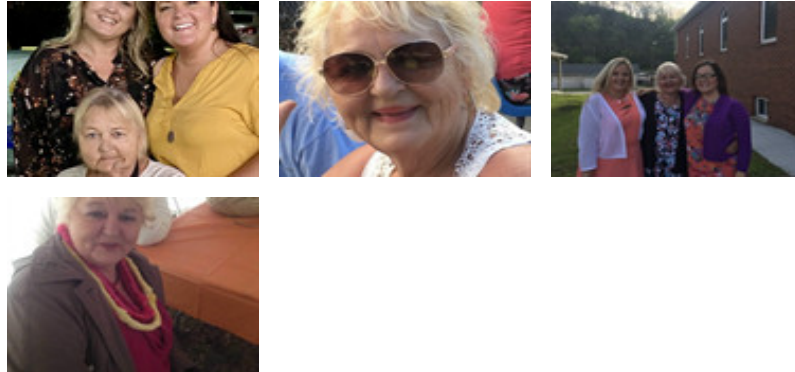
