THOMAS B. STEPHENSON, 86, of Moundsville, West Virginia, husband of Vandalia Faverty Stephenson, entered into eternal rest on Sunday, March 15, 2015. His funeral will be held Thursday, March 19, 2015 at 12 Noon at the Schneider-Griffin Funeral Home at 313 Big Branch Road, Chesapeake, OH. Burial will follow in Langdon Cemetery, Chesapeake, OH. The family will receive friends before the funeral from 11 AM to 12 Noon on Thursday. In addition, a memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. Friday, March 20, at Moundsville Baptist Church, 4th St. and Annadale Ave., Moundsville, WV.
